

PORTRAIT OF A TOWN "WORK AND PLAY" SCHOOLS PHOTOGRAPHY COMPETITION

The Photo Centre exhibition: *Portrait of a Town* will run in The Granary Gallery, Berwick-upon-Tweed from 29 May to 10 October 2021.

In addition to the exhibition, we are running a Schools Education programme, encouraging schools to use the resources on the Photo Centre website: https://www.photocentreberwick.co.uk/learning - visit the exhibition and take part in a photographic competition.

COMPETITION

The Competition is open to all schools in North Northumberland with the theme "Work and Play" which gives plenty of scope. The two workshops on the Photo Centre Berwick website will give the pupils guidance on taking photographs and creating a photo story. The entries must contain 5 photographs and there are two age categories:

- Up to and including Year 4
- Years 5 to Years 8

Schools can submit up to 3 entries from each class which will be judged by professional photographers, Jo Coates and Cameron Robertson. Winning entries and a selection of others will be on view in The Granary Gallery over the weekend 18 – 19 September as part of Berwick Heritage Open Days. They will also be archived and kept permanently in the Berwick Record Office.

Prizes

Pupils up to and including Year 4: 1^{st} prize: £30, 2^{nd} Prize: £15.

Pupils Years 5 to Years 8: 1st prize: £30, 2nd Prize: £15.

In addition, each prize winner and school will receive copies of the two Photocentre publications: *The Fifties in Focus* and *Snapshots of the Sixties*.
